

## UNIFORM DRESS CODE

Sacred Heart School implements a reasonable standard of dress that reflects Christian modesty and decorum and is intended to instill in each child a sense of school pride. Such standard of dress also reinforces and supports the orderly administration, operation, and discipline of the school for the benefit of the students and faculty. The standard of dress encourages an environment conducive to learning and enhancing the development of character and excellence in the lives of the students as they participate in the educational process.

### All Students Are Expected to Comply With the Uniform Dress Code As Stated Below:

<b><u>Spirit Day Uniform</u></b> <b>(Thursdays)</b>	<b><u>Girls</u></b> Navy shorts, skorts, or pants w/belt SHS t-shirt White socks (no lace or color)	<b><u>Boys</u></b> Navy shorts or pants w/belt SHS t-shirt White or navy socks

♥**Boys:** Earrings and piercings are not acceptable. Hair should not touch the shirt collar or the eyebrows.

♥**Girls:** SHS navy blue modesty shorts (with elastic waistbands or navy bike shorts) are to be worn **under the jumpers**. Girls wear uniform dress blouse under jumpers; **no polos, knit shirts, or t-shirts** should be worn with jumpers. Hair bows should be simple, **small** and in school colors: red, navy blue, SHS plaid, or white.

Jewelry must be kept to a minimum. Only one pair of small stud earrings (no loops or dangling) are allowed.

ITEMS NOT PERMITTED: **Capris, flood pants, sweatpants, leggings, fingernail polish, fake nails, and makeup are not allowed. (Girls will be sent to the office to remove fingernail polish & makeup.)**

When weather is predicted to be 40 degrees F or colder, turtlenecks may be worn in place of polos/blouses or under SHS t-shirts; tights may be worn with socks for same conditions.

♥**All: Children should come to school well-groomed, hair combed, and in clean, appropriate clothing.**

♥Ill-fitting uniforms, low-riding pants and clothing that is heavily worn, stained, soiled or torn are not permitted.

♥Belts must be worn when belt loops are present. (If a child can wear bottoms without belt, remove the loops.)

♥Shirrtails should be kept tucked into the pants/shorts/skort.

♥Shoes must be navy blue, white, black, brown, or red with closed-in toes and athletic-type soles. (No shoes with wheels, neon laces, flip flops, open heel or toe, character, light-up, high-heeled, platforms, sandals, or boots.)

♥**Socks must be visible; crew socks are preferred; no knee-high socks.**

♥**Jackets/Sweaters & outerwear for cold weather should be in school colors of solid red, white or navy.**

♥**Sweatshirts with logos or brand names are not allowed except for SHS logos/names.**

♥**Hairstyles should be simple with no fad or patterned haircuts or colors.**

♥**Tattoos are never acceptable. Hats, scarves, sunglasses are not permitted except for medical need.**

♥**Medical devices brought to school must prescribed by a doctor's written instructions.**

**Dress Uniform must be worn on all Mondays & SHS Mass Days (Fridays and other Holy Days of Obligation) and special days as announced, but they may be worn any school day.**

**School Uniforms are only to be worn when attending school, Mass, or officially representing SHS.**

**\*\*When a student's 3rd offense is for boys' long hair not being at regulation length, the student will be told that he may not return to classes until his hair is cut to regulation length.**
