As part of the Diocese of Corpus Christi, SHS is governed by the rules and membership in the Texas Catholic Conference of Bishops Education Dept. We are accredited through this organization which is sanctioned by the Texas Education Agency. Periodically, our school is reviewed by a team of educators who verifies that we are holding to the standards and principles needed for accreditation status. That process will be happening Feb. 19-22. There will be teachers/principals present on our campus, observing and interviewing teachers, staff, students, and parents. At the end of the review, our staff will receive the committee's report, and I need all of our staff to be present for this presentation. That is why our After School Program will be closed on Friday, February 22. Thank you for your understanding.

Things to think about: As parents/teachers, it is our job to prepare children for successfully meeting and handling life's challenges. Self-confident children are much more likely to tackle and overcome difficulties than those with little or no self-esteem. One of the easiest ways to help a child build self-confidence is to ask for that child's help. For instance, if your child is having trouble doing the tasks needed to get out the door in the morning, put him in charge. Create a checklist on a clipboard of stick-figure pictures of all the things he needs to do to get ready, and have him cross off each thing as it gets done. Be sure to compliment him on how impressed you are that he handled such a grown-up task. Positive remarks and a big smile from a parent can go a long way toward building self-esteem! It may take a few tries and plenty of time, but the reward is that your child now knows what he really can do when he tries.
